




3. Area of Activity: INDIA

4. Objects of the Trust:

ii) To promote employment opportunities through training as we as creating infrastructures and take i art in Swarn Jayanti Gram Swarojgar Yojana (SGSY) of Ministry of Rural Development, Govt, of India.

iii) To provide relief to the poor in cash or kind in the area of health, family planning, nutrition, immunization, AIDS awareness, maternal and childcare services their training information

iv) To undertake non-formal and formal literacy activities so as to strengthen and existing literacy base.

v)To take up programmers on youth development, sport, promotion, national integration camp. Maintaining communal harmony in the country etc.

vi)To create awareness on environmental issues; where necessary take up social forestry activities and work for overall development of Scheduled Castes/Tribes, Other Backward Castes, Minorities, Women etc.

vii) To help the destitute, disabled, handicapped and infirm by providing standard aids and appliances of quality to them to promote their physical rehabilitation.

xii) To give awards, scholarship, prizes, gift and provide assistance to deserving persons and arrange for studies and training at various institutions, and associates or otherwise situated within or outside country;

xiii) To set up school, colleges, establish and manage library, hospitals and other charitable institutions;

xiv) To take up management of other Trust, organizations, institutions, etc. and run them keeping in view objects the Trust;


xv) To open and establish branch office or other office all over India;

xvi) The Trust will work as a non profit making charitable institution;

xvii) To promote cultural and .or entertainment facilities of rural areas.

xviii) To do all such acts in addition to and in furtherance of the above objects and in advancement of any other Charitable object of general utility.





5. BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

a. The board of trustees will ordinarilly consist of not less than seven and not more than eleven emembers. The founder and Athor of the trust naming Mr. Sunil Kumar Singh shall hold office for life and other trustee shall hold office for three years and elect president, seceratary & treasurer among themselves. These will form the Board of Trustees.

b. The other trustees are liable for retirment whose or office expire after the period of three syears. but they are illegible to be co-opted by the Founder and Author. The trustees may if so desires resign his trusteeship even before the expiry of them of his her trusteeship.




6. OWER AND DUTIES:

a) the Trust may accept any donation or contribution in cash or in kind from any person, firm company, corporation, association institution or Trust for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust or any one or more of them upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees to their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistent with the objects of the Trust. The Trustees may also take over the management of any other Trust or public institution and/or affiliate itself to or affiliate another Trust having the same objects terms on such tram as the Trustees in the trust of think fit.



- b) The Trustees shall invest the properties and moneys of the Trust in such manner as prescribed under section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and other statutory laws.
- c) The Trustees may borrow if need be, against security of the assets of the Trust by way of bank overdrafts, loans or otherwise as may be necessary, for the benefit of the Rust and for more effectively carrying out the objects of the Trust, provided however the trustees unanimously agrees in advance on such borrowing and limited to the terms of their decision or agreement and may authorize two or more of the Trustees to execute such documents deeds paper, etc. as may be necessary in connection therewith.
- d) The Trustees may authorize an one or more Trustees to hold any property or any fund or any investments of the Trust subject however to the terms of these presents in such manner and subject to such terms and conditions, rules and regulations as the Board of Trustees may, from time to time think fit and proper to adopt.
- e) If need arises, the Trustees may invest the Trust Estate either in the purchase of immovable properties or of mortgage immovable properties, or in such manner is allowed by law as may be in forced from time to time and to convert, alter, vary, dispose of or transfer such a state are from time to time, provided that such investments shall not be made which are directly or indirectly for the





and to execute all conveyances or other assurances and to pass valid and effectual receipts and discharges for all money received by them.

g) The Trustees may manage or supervise the management of lands, heriditaments, and premises for ' the e time being compromised in the Trust Estate or any part thereof with power to erect, pull, down, rebuild, add to alter and repair houses and other buildings and to keep the same insured against loss or damage by fire and / pr other risks for the benefit of the Trust.

h) If need arises, the Trustees may devide the immovable property or property belonging to the trust either from year to year or for any fixed term or for any erms of ye monthly tenancies at such rent and subject to such convenience and conditions as proper and also accept surrenders of lease and tenancies and generally markage manner as they think fit.

- i) The Board or Trustees shall meet at least twice in a year and their proceedings shall be recorded regularly in a minute book to be maintained for the purpose. In any resolution to be passed touching the administration of the trust, the opinion of the majority shall prevail. It shall be competent, however for the trustees to decide matters by circulation. Incase of there being equality of votes, the President of the meetings of deciding the issue.
- j) A resolution in writing circulated amongst all the Trustees and signed by a majority oof the Trustees shall be valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the Trustees duly called and convened.
- k) The Trustees may open and operate account (s) with any scheduled bank or banks or regional rural bank and the accounts will be operated jointly by any two among the Managing Trustee/ President, Secretary and Treasurer.
- l) The Board may be resolution extent the activities of the Trust or undertakes any activity in furtherance of the main objects of the Trust, and /or amends the same from time to time.
- m) Proper Books of accounts shall be maintained in the name of the Trust and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant. The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all money received and spent and of all matter in respect thereof in course of management f Trust properties of in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purpose of the Trust as well as of the assets, credits and effects of the Trust properties.
- n) To do such other lawful things as are incidentals in carrying out the administration and management of the Trust.
- o) The Trustees may frame rules and regulations as to the duties and responsibilities of each Trustees, to appoint sub committees, and to determine mode of conducting any other matters connected with the administration/furtherance of the objects of the Trust.
- p) The Trustees shall from time to time after meeting the expenses and incidental to the management of the Trust properties and of the Trust decide the particular object of objects for which the income or corpus of the Trust Fund or properties for the time being available shall be applied.
- q) If the income from the Trust property in a particular year is not fully telexed the unexpended income subject to the applicable p0-rovisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent year or years for the advancement of any of the objects of the Trust.
- r) The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the Trust fund all expenses incurred by them in or about the execution of the Trust or any of their duties under these presents including traveling expenses, but will not be entitled to any remuneration.

- s) The Trustees may employ/appoint such staff, from time to time as may be deemed necessary in the usual course of business carried out by the Trust for the further advancement of the objects aforementioned and / or dismiss the same. The Trustees may appoint sub-Committees of the Trustees and /or others to attend to or supervise or conduct specified jobs or Trust matters in such manner and subject to such rule and regulations as the Trustees mazy prescribe.
- t) The Trustees may appoint Managers, Lawyers, Auditors, Architects and other technical staffs for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust.
- u) The Trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions, suits and other pro9ceedings and settle differences and dip-uses touching the Trust Estate and/or the Trust properties and to do all other acts and things fully and effectual without being liable or answerable for any bonfire loss occasioned thereby.
- v) No Trustee shall be liable for any loss not attributable to his own dishonesty or of omission by him of an act amounting to breach or Trust.

7. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS:

The managing Trustee or his nominee or any other Trustee if so authorized by the Board of Trustees shall have the custody or all the documents, deeds of title relating to the Trust priorities and investment and the books of account and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the preservation of the same.

8. FINANCIAL YEAR:

The financial year of the Trust will commence on 1st April and will end on 31 March of the next year.

9. IRREVOCABILITY:

It is declared that the <u>Trust is irrevocable</u>. If the <u>Trust fails</u> for any reason, in the opinion of <u>the Trustees</u>, the nit assets of the <u>Trust both</u> movable and immovable shall be

handed over to any other Trust/Charitable Organization having the same or similar objects as decided by the majority or the Trustees.
